GENERAL INFORMATION

Judging will commence at 10 a.m. The judges determination shall be final and not subject to review.

The Show Chairman may change an entrant to a more appropriate skill level. The Show Chairman may move a carving to another division or to a more appropriate category than the original entry, with consultation with the artist.

RULES AND PRINCIPALS OF PARTICIPATION

The show is open to all carvers of all skill levels. All work entered must be entirely the work of the carver as described on the entry form signed by the carver. If the carving is by more than one person all names must be on the entry form and on any entry tag.

Carvings should have been completed within the last two years. A carver may repeat an entry to see if a better award can be won the following year, unless the carver won a Best of Division in Advanced or a Best of Show. A carving may be moved up one skill level, above the carvers skill level to see if a better award can be won.

Carvers are only required to advance in the division in which they have achieved the appropriate qualifications. Carvers may step down one level in one or more divisions.

The Society of the Central Fraser Valley Woodcarvers and its members and any officer or employees of Parks, Rec. & Culture cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage from any causes before, during or after the show.

SKILL LEVELS

Youth: 18 and under (no entry fee). First, Second & Third Ribbons presented in this category all divisions combined. Carvers who have won a Best of Division Award in Youth should move up to Novice in that specific category.

Novice: For beginning carvers. Carvers who have won 5 first place awards, on separate carvings or 2 Best of Division awards in Novice must move up to the intermediate level. Carvers are only required to move up in the categories in which they have taken a best of division award.

Intermediate: For carvers who have 5 first place awards, on separate carvings or 2 Best of Division awards in Novice. Carvers who have won 2 Best of Divisions in Intermediate must move up to Advanced. Carvers may elect to move up in all categories or just those in which they have taken a Best of Division Award.

Advanced: After having won 3 Best of Division awards, with one Best of Division at two different PNC shows the carver should, but is not required to move up to Expert.

Expert: For carvers who have won 3 Best of Division Awards, one each on different carvings, the one Best of Division having been won at each of any two different shows, at the Advanced Level, in any “one” Division. This skill level will require a high degree of artistic presentation and skilled craftsmanship. Expert Carvings are judged in Six Categories (Divisions) Only.
